Importance of creating a personal profile in Web of Science

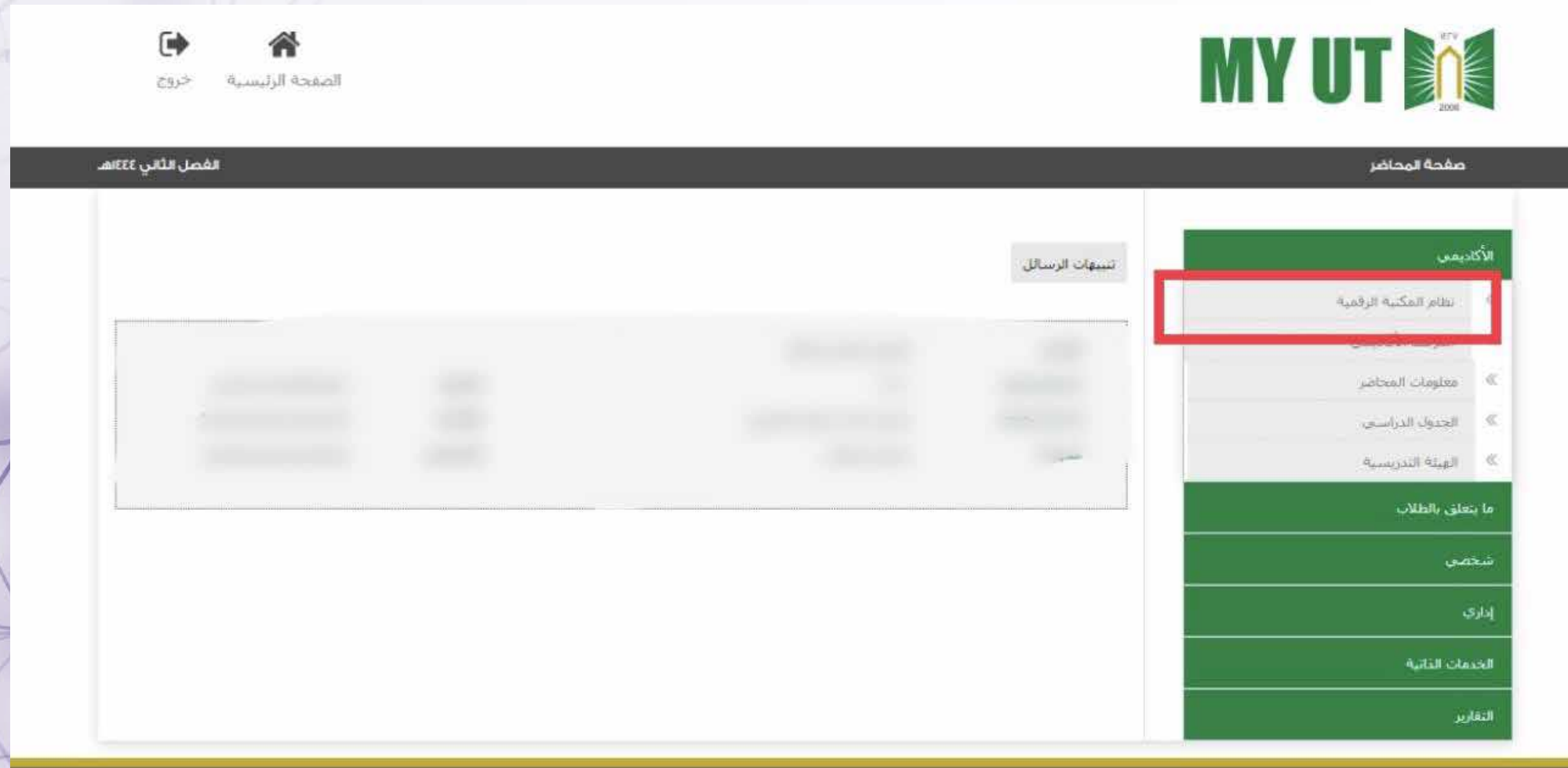
- **Increases research visibility and subsequently increases research citation.**

Web of Science ResearcherID

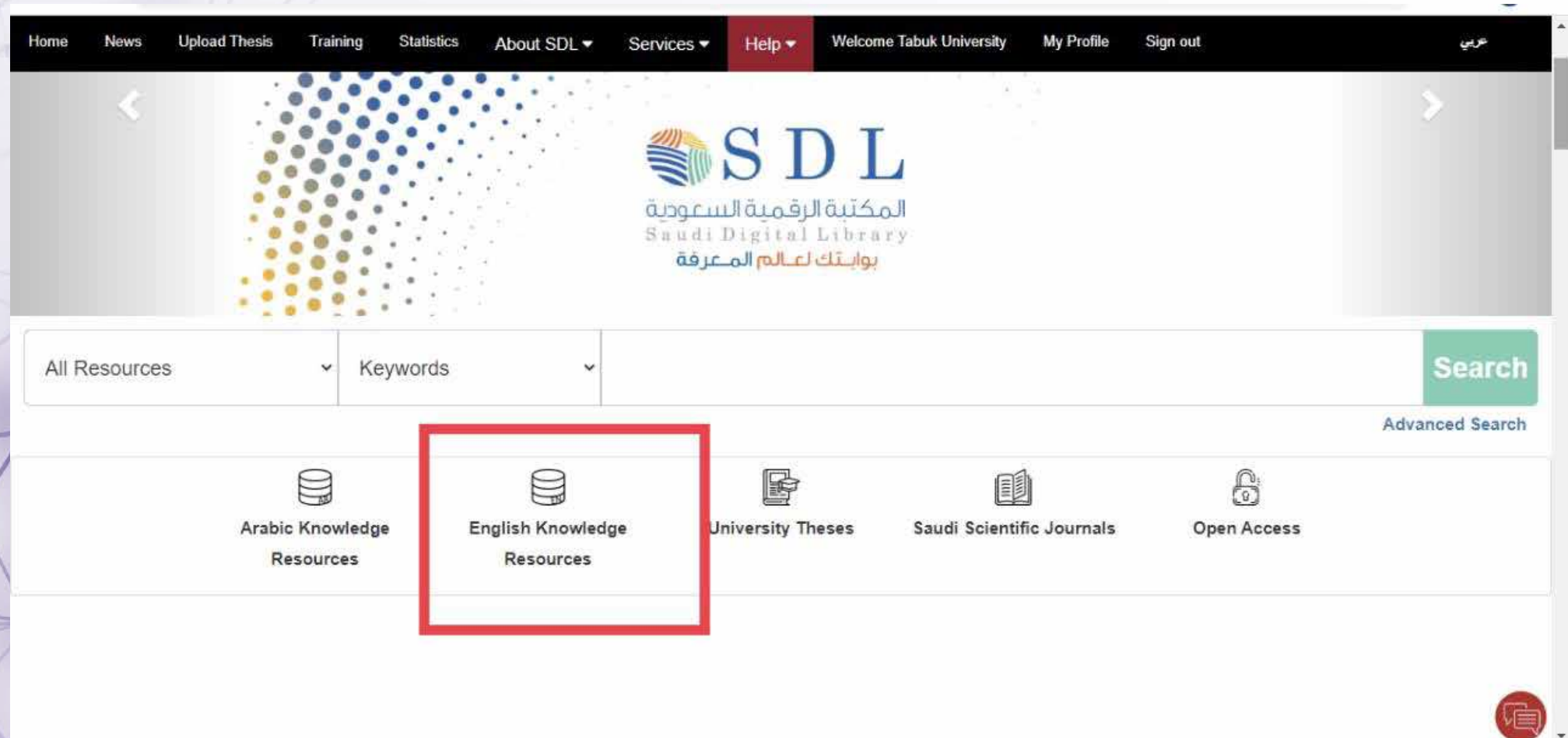
A Web of Science ResearcherID is a unique identifier that differentiates researchers in the Web of Science. Having a ResearcherID does not mean that the author's record has been claimed by the researcher. Researchers can claim author records that have not already been claimed by someone else, or add publications in an author record to an existing claimed researcher profile.

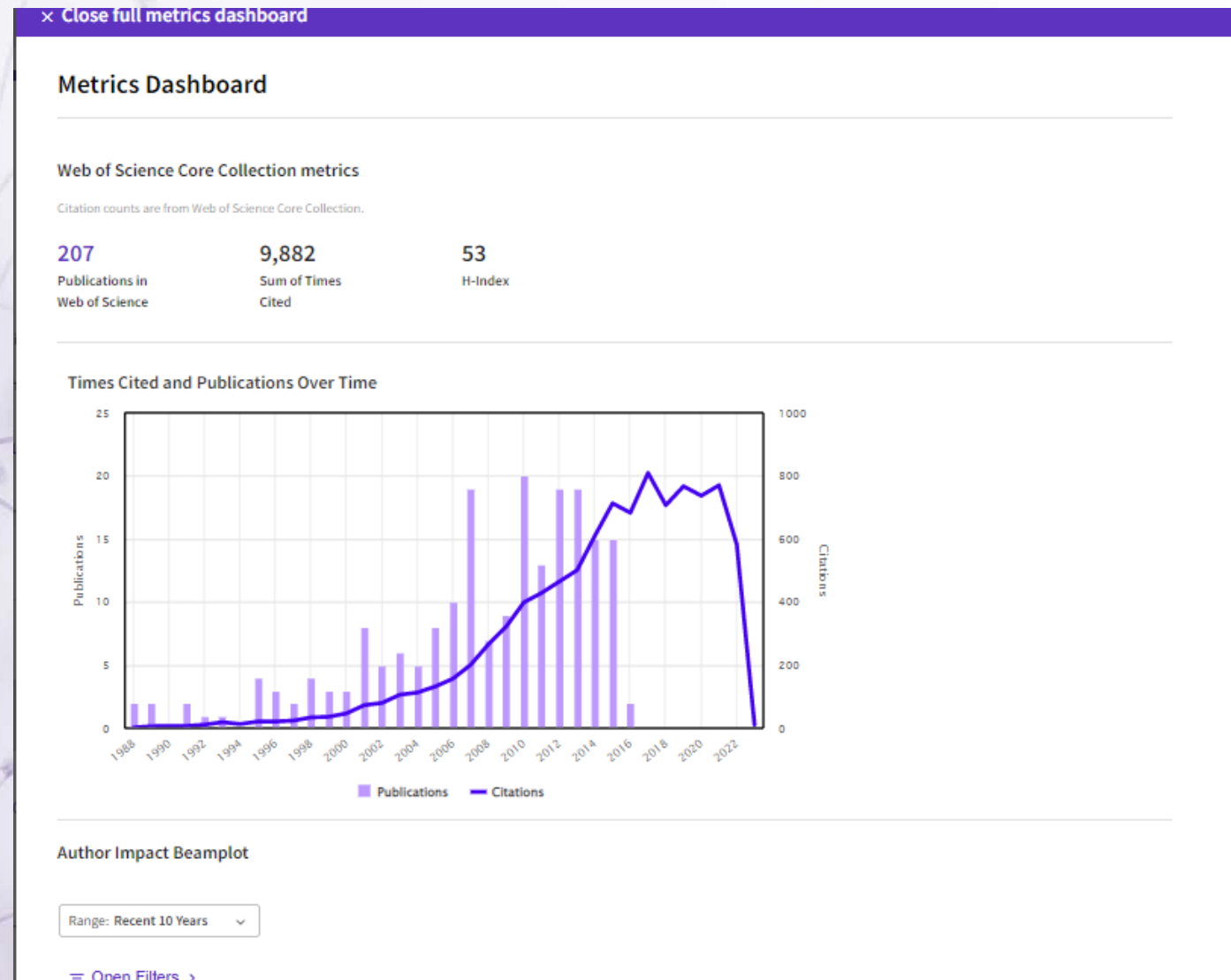

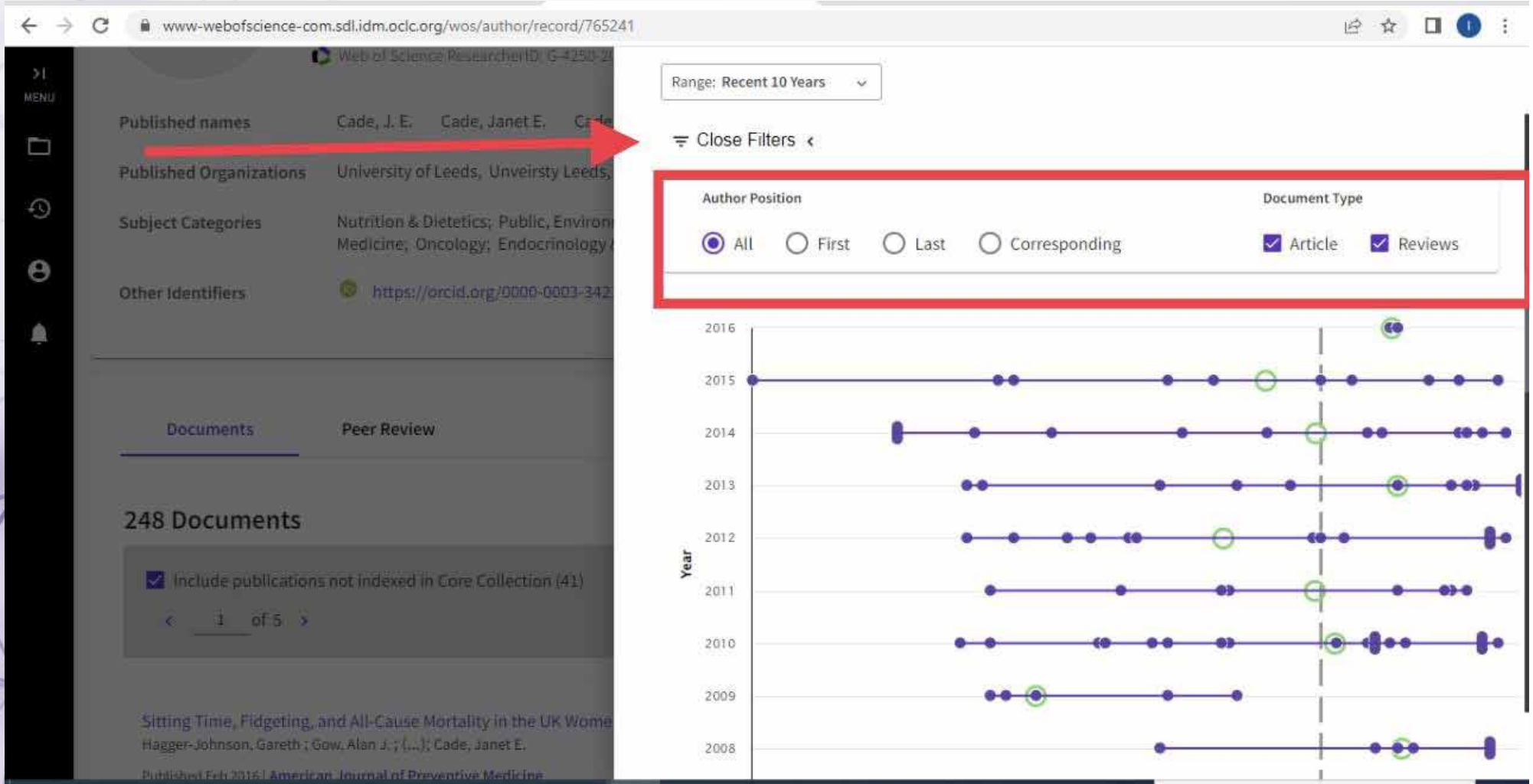

Geographic Citation Map

The citation map shows the distribution of the researcher's citations across the globe:

- For each article in the Web of Science Core Collection that cited the researcher's work, a city with a contributing author's institution represents a data point
