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In connection to World Pharmacist Day, the Department of Pharmacy Practice, Faculty of Pharmacy, University of Tabuk organized the community awareness program on obesity, hypertension, and type-2-diabetes Mellitus held at Al Makhan Mall, Tabuk, KSA during 4th October 2019. All the faculty members in the department of pharmacy practice and fifthyear male and female students involved in the program. The primary aim of this program was to create awareness about the symptoms, risk factors and complications of the above-said diseases among the Tabuk population who visited Al-Makhan Mall on the day of the program. Also, to deliver health screening services on body mass index (BMI), blood pressure (BP) and blood sugar level. In addition to this, offering patient education according to their risk factors, BMI, BP, and Blood Sugar level.





Many of both male and female were vo lunteered to participate after knowing the above-said objectives. According to the need, they were advised to follow some aspects including life style modifications, smoking cessation, medication adherence, frequently monitoring the above-said parameters. Moreover, some patients who had high BP were advised to meet the physician immediately.
