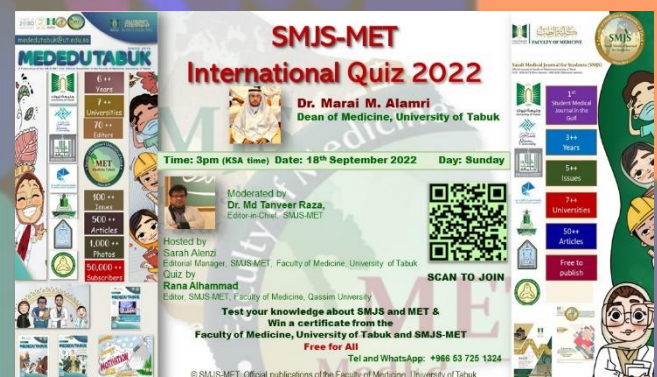

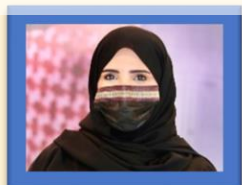

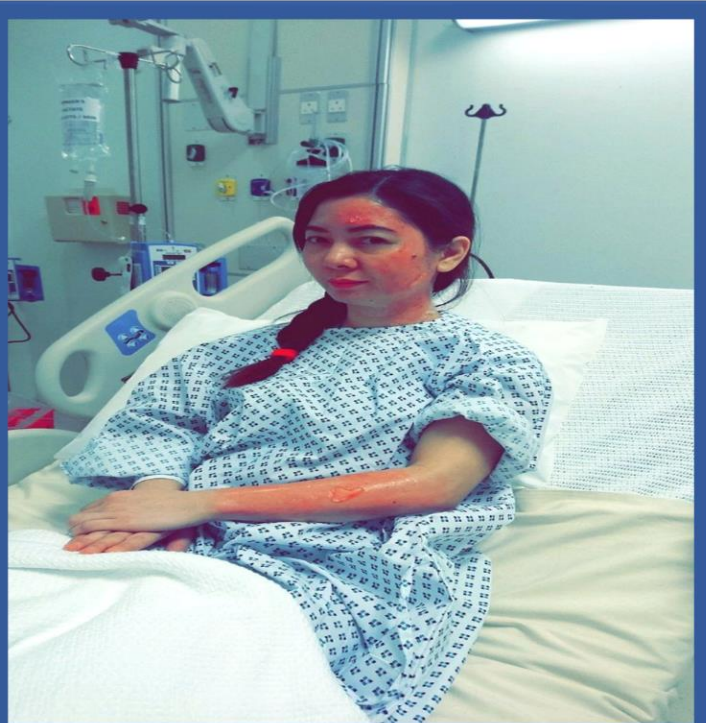


Standardized Patient Program (SPP):
