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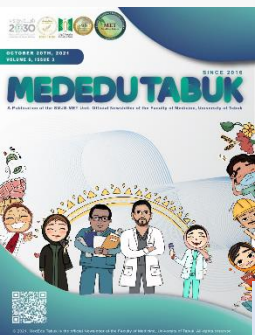
The benefit of being on the Editorial Board of SMJS-MET

Competencies of Medical Graduates: Developing a Framework at The Faculty of Medicine

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The mission Statement of the MBBS Program at the Faculty of Medicine is, "*Providing an exceptional and attractive medical education, and pioneering research that graduates qualified skilled doctors at service to their communities.*" A workshop by the Deanship of Medicine was organized to develop a framework for the competencies of Medical Graduates at the Faculty of Medicine, University of Tabuk, to identify the specific competencies for its graduates. Colleagues from all departments (Basic and Clinical) and senior student representatives took part in this workshop.





Doctors have to take multiple complex roles to serve the community effectively. For this, medical students have to develop a complex set of knowledge, skills, and attitudes described as competencies upon graduation. These competencies are usually classified into well-defined specific thematic roles. Therefore, it is vital to identify the essential competencies that graduates of each Medical institution should have to effectively meet the health care needs of the people they are to serve.

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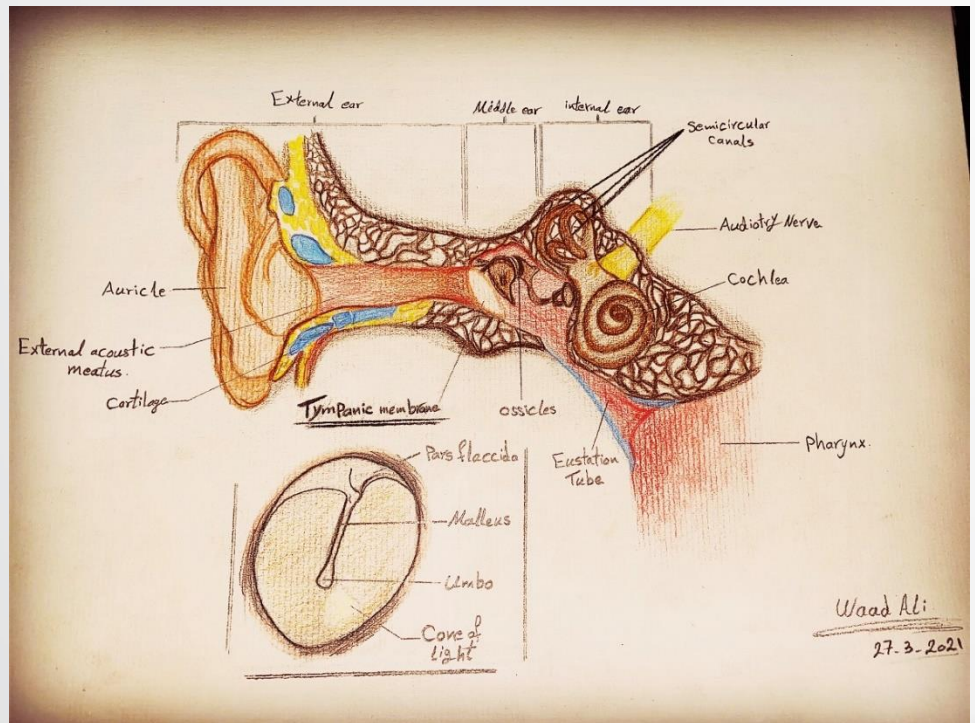
