
EDVARD MUNCH

He is a Norwegian painter who follows the Expressionist school. He was born in 1863. He was the second of his parents' five sons. After his mother passed away from tuberculosis, a series of tragedies began for his family. His sister died for the same reason, and his older sister was admitted to the mental health hospital, and his brother died of pneumonia. In the beginning, he studied engineering, but he left it after one year, after his passion for art surpassed his passion for engineering. In a short time, he created a large series of 22 paintings called Frieze of Life, to be shown at the Berlin Gallery. Perhaps the names that he used to give to his paintings made his mental and psychological state quite clear, and his style varied greatly based on the emotional state that controlled him at the time of the painting. This group of paintings was a colossal success, and shortly afterwards Monk achieved international fame in the art scene. The success was not enough for him to live happily, he suffered from partial paralysis and did not produce great works after that. Monk moved to a country house and lived in it alone to begin landscape painting. Monk continued to paint until his death, often depicting his contrasting emotions and multiple physical ailments in his works. He died in his home country in 1944.
