### **What is TPI about?**

- It is about quantifying the *Five* common perspective (*Transmission, Apprenticeship, Developmental, Nurturing and Social Reform*) of teachers on teaching adults and in higher education
- It is a well-researched and utilized instrument often used for Faculty development

### **What is TPI not about?**

- It is not about “good” or “bad” teaching
- It is not about “teaching styles” or “teaching methods”
- There is no “right” or “wrong” perspective/ point of view

### **What is the benefit?**

- TPI will help you identify your dominant perspective on teaching
- It would help you to recognize yourselves as an educator
- In cases of evaluation, it can help you justify your approach to teaching

### **What do I do with my results?**

- Results are for your self-reflection. You do not have to share your results
- We like to invite you to share with your colleagues. It would give them an insight to their own teaching perspective
