2- Research & Reviewer Experience

3- The Head of Department Duties and Responsibilities

Dr. Abuelhassan's responsibilities as the Head of the Department (HOD) at the Colleges of Tourism and Hospitality in Malaysia and Saudi Arabia are outlined below:
