## The launch of the first Gulf Championship of "Bocce" sports in Tabuk. https://www.spa.gov.sa/Ofbf7fbb1cw



Under the patronage of His Royal Highness Prince Fahd bin Sultan bin Abdulaziz, the Governor of Tabuk Region, the first Gulf Championship of "Bocce" sports opened yesterday in its second edition, with the participation of 67 players representing 15 Gulf and local clubs.

The competitions, held at the indoor sports hall of Tabuk University, will continue for 4 days under the slogan "You are from us, and we are with you." The event is organized by the Disability Club in the region in cooperation with the Development Initiatives Center in the Emirate of Tabuk, with technical supervision from the Saudi Bocce Federation. It focuses on individuals with moderate to severe quadriplegic disabilities.

Mohammed Al-Bluwi from the Tabuk Disability Club won the first round in the individual category, defeating Ahmed Kaddadi from the Al-Hassa Disability Club with a score of 6 - 0. Meanwhile, Ziaar Al-Shammari from Hail Club secured the first place after defeating Ahmed Al-Suwaidan from the Eastern Province Disability Club with a score of 4 - 1. Additionally, Zahraa Al-Abeid from Al-Hassa Club won the first place against Fatima Farhan from Asir Club with a score of 9 - 0. Mohammed Al-Zahrani from Riyadh Club won against Sayaf Al-Sayaf from Asir Club with a score of 7 - 0.

In the second round, Abdulaziz Al-Majbel from Al-Ahsa Club secured the first place by defeating Nawaf Al-Ruwaili from Al-Jouf Club with a score of 4 - 2. Lujain Al-Thaqafi from Al-Ahsa Club won against Sulaiman Al-Rateiq from Riyadh Club with a score of 6 - 2. Ziad Al-Juhani from Al-Medina Club secured the first place by defeating Sakhr Al-Ruwaili from Al-Jouf Club with a score of 15 - 1. The round ended with Mamdouh Barouza from the Eastern Province Club winning against his competitor Nayef Al-Qahtani from Riyadh Disability Club with a score of 4 - 3.

Clinical Psychology Unit https://www.ut.edu.sa/ar/Units/clinical-psychology-unit/Pages/default.aspx After the opening of the University of Tabuk's program for postgraduate studies in clinical psychology (Master's and Higher Diploma), in cooperation with the Faculty of Psychology at the University of South Australia, the Clinical Psychology Unit was established at the University of Tabuk based on the decision of His Excellency the University President No. (31/11/72 BC) dated (02/05/1431). It is worth noting that this is the first practical, educational, service-based clinical psychology unit at the level of public and private Saudi higher education.

#### Vision

The Clinical Psychology Unit seeks to be an example to be emulated in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the Arab world in employing knowledge of psychology in general and clinical psychology in particular for the well-being of individuals and their achievement of their maximum potential in life.

#### the message

The mission of the Clinical Psychology Unit at the University of Tabuk is to support and provide training programs for psychologists that are based on the scientist-practitioner model and to support and provide psychological service that is based on evidence and on the standards of the best psychological service for individuals who face one or more different psychological difficulties.

-Providing the necessary infrastructure to achieve the highest quality rates in clinical training

-Providing high-quality services in psychological evaluation

-Providing opportunities to conduct clinical psychological studies for researchers in the field of psychological disorders

-Developing community service programs aimed at prevention and general mental health

#### Unit Manager

The University of Tabuk, in cooperation with the College of Psychology at the University of South Australia, was the only one to open the first clinical psychological program, locally and in the Arab world, subject to criteria by adopting the model of the practicing scientist in the rehabilitation of specialists in clinical psychology and with the best practice and clinical psychological training that is internationally recognized in the name


(The Scientist- Practitioner).

And the University of Tabuk, as it works to establish international quality standards for clinical psychological training, but rather fills a great void in psychological care created by the absence of clinical psychological training programs in the Arab world that operate with these standards. Thus, Tabuk University, as part of the higher education system, seeks to contribute to the localization of

international quality standards in all areas of training and service, including those standards related to clinical psychological training and psychological services for individuals from inside and outside the university.

With the establishment of the University of Tabuk's clinical psychology programs, it opens a closed door for Saudi and Arab psychology students who wish to obtain clinical psychological training qualified for advanced clinical practice. Admission to clinical psychology programs in Western universities is almost impossible, except in very special cases, which has led to the development of traditions of psychological practice far removed from the reality of clinical psychology service and its standards in developed countries in the field of psychological care.

The unit provided clinical rehabilitation for eight batches in the clinical psychology program, forming a nucleus through which the unit's message grows and flourishes in institutions concerned with health care in general, and care.


